Download from: <http://www.microsoft.com/express/database/>

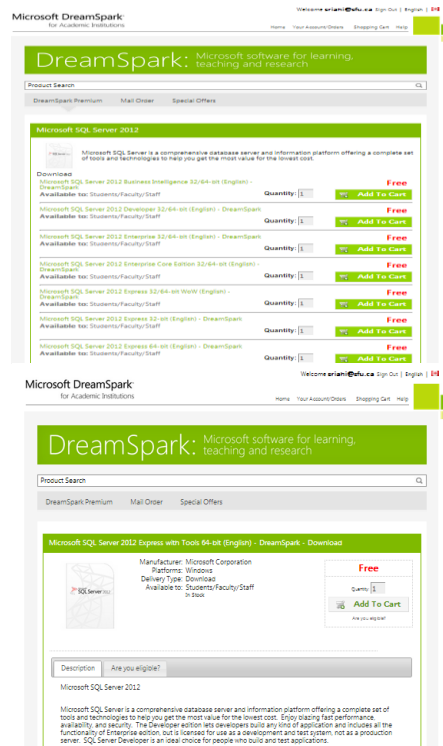
OR login to MSDNAA and download it from that website:

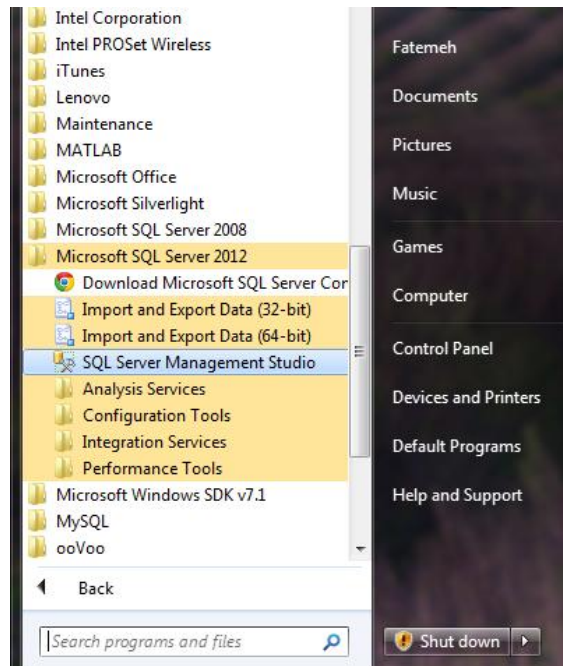


Install everything and click next

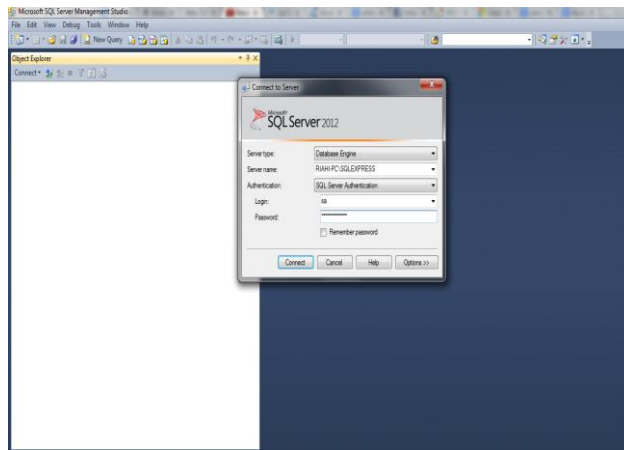


Account name = your logon for Windows (mine was administrator)

 Click NEXT.



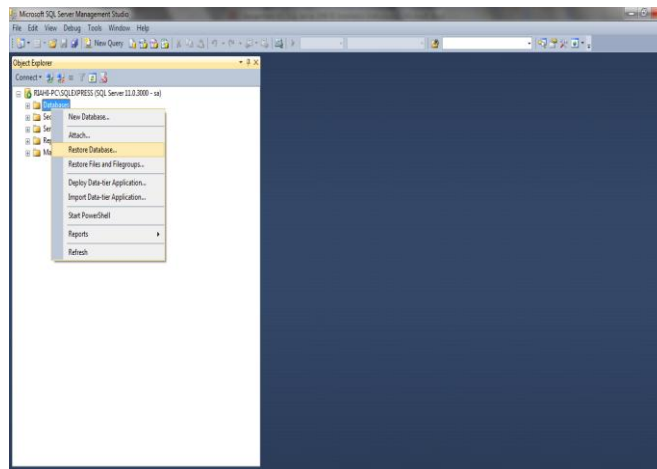


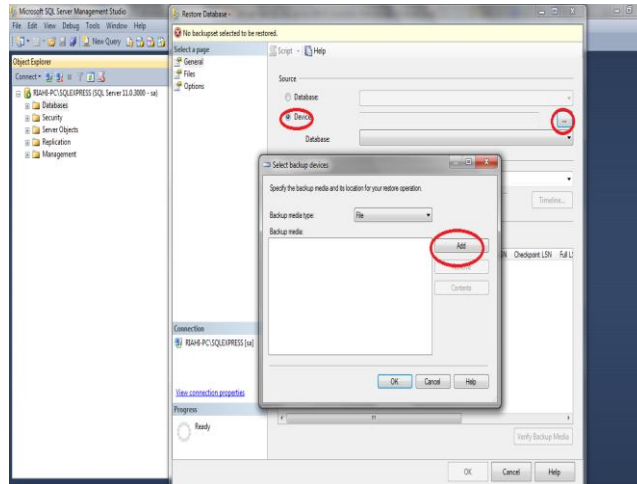
Load up SQL Server Management Studio.



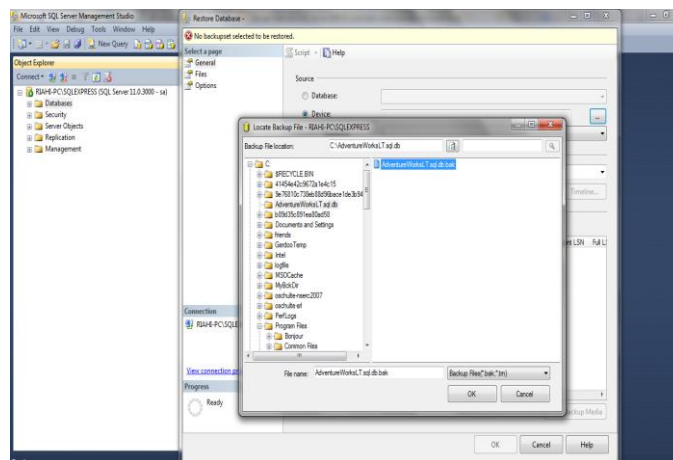
Change Authentication to 'SQL Server...'

Right click on 'Databases' → 'Restore Database'.



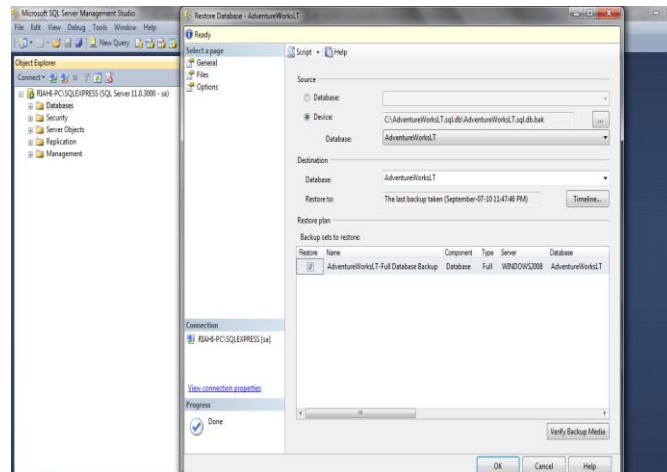


Select 'From Device'.  
Click on '...' beside 'From Device'.



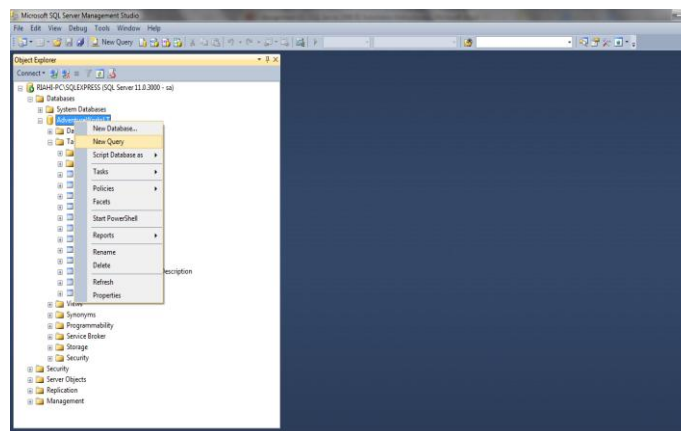
Navigate to where you uncompressed the database you downloaded.

Click OK.



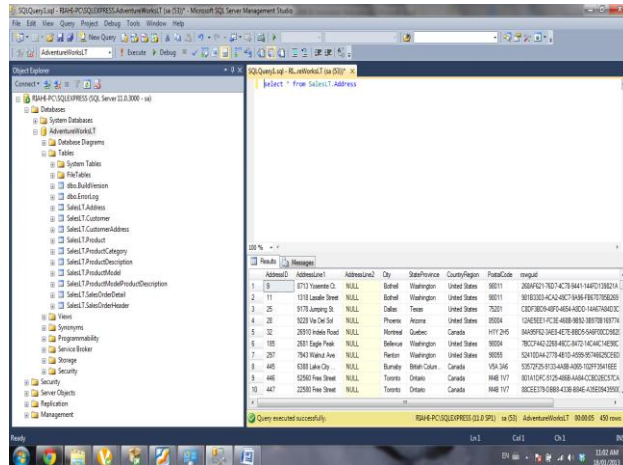


Check off the box in the first row.
