## ***Motor Vehicle Act***

### **MOTORCYCLE SAFETY HELMET EXEMPTION REGULATION**

**Note:** Check the Cumulative Regulation Bulletin 2012 and 2013 for any non-consolidated amendments to this regulation that may be in effect.

#### **Exemption**

**1** The following persons are exempt from the requirements of [section 221](#) of the *Motor Vehicle Act*:

- (a) a person who
  - (i) practices the Sikh religion, and
  - (ii) has unshorn hair and habitually wears a turban composed of 5 or more square meters of cloth.
